- Technical Chairmen: enroll Reviewers, manage abstracts and evaluation synthesis; communicate with Authors
- Program Chairmen: quickly build up the technical program, ensuring consistency of its published derivatives (Web version, printed version, proceedings table of content), feed TeX system to release proceedings, reduce risks and leadtime between deadline for final papers delivery and the launch of printed or CD proceedings.
